At the city art fair, there were <u>exhibits</u> of paintings, sculpture, and children's book illustrations\_by local artists. In addition, a stained glass artist offered a <u>demonstration</u>, working on a stained glass window so people could see the process. Almost all the <u>visual</u> arts were on <u>display</u>. This exhibition was held in the city's new <u>convention</u> center so more people could attend. All the local <u>media--</u> the local TV channel, both newspapers, and the public radio station-- reported on the art fair.

Companies that produce large medical <u>equipment</u> like X-ray or MRI machines need <u>access</u> to the latest <u>technical</u> advances. They also need managers who care about <u>qualitative</u> evaluation and controls, and are not just concerned about the <u>volume</u> of machinery they can sell. If they <u>export</u> a large <u>percentage</u> of their production to other countries, they also need an understanding of the <u>complexities</u> of different health care systems in those countries. The <u>route</u> to success in such an industry is careful attention to detail in every aspect of production, inspection, and shipping. Their motto should be, "Don't take any procedure for <u>granted</u>. Check everything twice!"
